This year we offer to participant of the SES2021 to submit their papers for publications in Accountancy and Business. We welcome papers that advance the theory and practice of social entrepreneurship. Contributions based on a broad variety of methodologies are welcome, including literature review, conceptual paper, quantitative or qualitative methods.

We look for submissions on the following topics:

- Social Entrepreneurship and their innovative business models;
- Building a strong and supportive ecosystem to support social entrepreneurs;
- Social entrepreneurship and BoP context (with attention to vulnerable communities and disadvantaged groups);
- Social innovation (including presentation of best practices and cases);
- The role of universities to promote and support social entrepreneurship;
- Case studies of successful social entrepreneurs;
- Circular economy and new business models.

This is not an exhaustive list of topics. The editors are welcome to discuss any other proposals related to social entrepreneurship, which should have been previously presented during the SES2021.

Timeline for this special issue:

- Announcing your interest to be part of this special issue (via E-mail) with the title of your work and the author(s) before the 31st of October;
- Submission of full paper: 1st of December;
- Peer review process: 5th December 2020 to 15th January 2022;
- Reviews provided to authors, revision and resubmission of papers: 15th January to 28 of February 2022;
- Publication expected in May 2022.
